

## Upper Beginner Level, Unit 3

### Directly Modifying with Descriptive Verbs

When the last syllable of the stem ends in a vowel: add ㄴ

싸다 (to be cheap), 빠르다 (to be fast)

**CONJUGATION:** 싸다 > 싸 > 싼 (a cheap)

빠르다 > 빠르 > 빠른 (a fast)

#### Example sentences

- 싼 것이 있어요? **Do you have anything cheap?**
- 저는 빠른 차를 좋아해요. **I like fast cars.**

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### Directly Modifying with Descriptive Verbs

Since 하다 stem ends in a vowel: add ㄴ

조용하다 (to be quiet), 착하다 (to be kind)

**CONJUGATION:** 조용하다 > 조용하 > 조용한 (a quiet)

착하다 > 착하 > 착한 (a kind)

#### Example sentences

- 조용한 방이 있어요? Do you have any quiet rooms?
- 착한 친구가 필요해요. I need a kind friend.

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### Directly Modifying with Descriptive Verbs

When the last syllable of the stem ends in a consonant: add 은  
많다 (to be many), 작다 (to be small)

**CONJUGATION:** 많다 > 많 > 많은 (many)

작다 > 작 > 작은 (a small)

#### Example sentences

- 거리에 많은 주차 장소가 있어요. There's lots of parking space on the street.
- 나는 작은 애완동물을 정말 좋아해요. I really like a small pet.
